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Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival for Uganda and Rwanda Wildlife Tour

Morning: On arrival, your driver/ guide will receive you at the Entebbe international Airport and transfer you to the Hotel for a night in Entebbe. Depending on the time of arrival, you will be guided on a leisurely walk to the Entebbe Botanical Gardens. These Botanical gardens boost a prolific birdlife, three primate species and other smaller mammals. The gardens are a heaven for botany enthusiasm and should introduce to African primates and other wildlife during this tour.

Overnight at Lake Victoria View Guesthouse (Full Board) Two Twin Rooms plus one Single

Price: \$350 per person (including accommodation, meals, and park fees).

Day 2: Visit Mabamba Wetlands in Search for the Shoebill

Morning: After breakfast, your birding experience to the Mabamba Swamps will start. Birding here is done canoeing on a big scale. We are very aware that this is not a binding tour but chasing in Africa's most sought after bird for your experience should be amazing. With good luck you should lock eyes with this pre-historic looking bird, this is the kind of moment that will linger.

Overnight at Lake Victoria Guesthouse (Full Board)

Price: Included in Day 1 package.

Day 3: Transfer to Murchison Falls National Park

Morning: After an early breakfast and with packed lunch, we get on the journey to Murchison Falls National Park. The most beautiful protected area in Uganda. We proceed to the top of the iconic Murchison falls from which the park gets her name; this is where the world's longest river (River Nile) explodes violently through a narrow cleft in the Great rift escarpment to plunge into a frothing pool 43m below.

Overnight at Murchison Falls River Lodge (full board)

Price: \$400 per person (including accommodation, meals, and park fees).

Day 4: Murchison Falls National Park

Morning: Start the day with an early morning Game Drive on the B.O. Albert or Queens tracks north of river Nile. View a variety of wild game.

Afternoon: At 14:00hrs after lunch it is time for a launch cruise for game viewing at close quarters; this is a paradise for hippos and crocodiles and, a fascinating birdlife among which by a small chance might include the Shoebill-Africa's most sought-after bird.

Day 5: Murchison Falls - Kibale National Park

Morning: Have breakfast and with packed lunch be driven through verdant countryside, past traditional homesteads and farms to Kibale Forest National Park. This will take you through the homes of the people in the typical Uganda villages.

Overnight at Kibale Forest Camp (Full Board)

Price: \$420 per person (including accommodation, meals, and park fees).

Day 6: Kibale National Park - Chimpanzee Tracking

Morning: After breakfast, report to Kanyandu Tourist centre where tourist activities begin. You will be briefed by a ranger guide then set out to track man's closest relatives. The Chimpanzee in the forest. The Kibale Forest National Park is a home of the endangered Chimpanzee and boasts of having the highest concentrations of primates in East Africa and probably Africa since the potential competitor - the Congo forest has been poorly researched. Other primate species include the globally threatened Red Colobus Monkey, Black and White Colobus, Blue monkey Bush Babies, the Nocturnal Potto and Galagos name it.

Afternoon: After lunch the tour continues to Bigedi wetland, here is a community based activity that was set up to enable tourists give back to the community and yet enjoy the nature offered by the swamp like many colorful butterflies, birds and other plant species. This is another moment with the natives of the area hence take a look at their way of life.

Stay at Kibale Lodge (Full board)

Day 7: Crater Lake

Morning: You will have breakfast before proceeding for an exploration of the crater lakes. Enjoy the beauty of the many small lakes, surrounded by gentle hills, and the stunning views.

Stay at Kibale Home Stay (Full Board)

Price: \$380 per person (including accommodation, meals, and park fees).

Day 8: Kibale Forest National Park - Queen Elizabeth National Park

Morning: After breakfast, you will be transferred to Queen Elizabeth National Park. On entering Queen Elizabeth, expect seeing Waterbucks, Elephants, Leopards, Buffaloes, Hyenas and a variety of Antelope species. This Park has the highest record of mammals in the entirety and is the second in the world after Murchison Falls National Park.

Stay at Bush Lodge (Full Board) Two double and one single non-self contained tents.

Day 9: Queen Elizabeth National Park

Morning: The day begins early as we head for the mating ground (lek) of the Uganda kobs, search for lions, elephants, buffaloes and other big and small game in their natural habitats. We return for lunch and in the afternoon get on the unique launch cruise on the Kazinga Channel and into Lake Edward. This lingering (retire) takes you through possibly the highest concentration of Hippos and many animals are often seen drinking at the water edges. The cruise is an excellent platform for photography and birdwatching too.

Itinerary

Day 10: Queen Elizabeth - Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

Morning: We have breakfast and with packed lunch, we go for another game drive for more game possibly missed on the previous game drives. From the game drive, we transfer to the prime home of the endangered Mountain Gorillas- Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

Day 11: Mountain Gorilla Tracking in Bwindi

Morning: At 08.00hour you will be guided to the ranger station for registration and a briefing by the ranger guide. Then you will be taken into the sanctuary to enjoy the beauty and freshness of the forestry the home to over a half of the world mountain gorillas for your memorable experience. The tracking activity takes 2 to 8 hours and on meeting the Gorillas, at most one hour is allowed with them, some fitness is required. (Option small walk) Back to the lodge (Full board)

Day 12: Transfer to Uganda's Deepest Lake Bunyonyi

Morning: The tour continues through Idzezi terraces, look at the magnificent looking scenery in Bunyonyi and in good time for lunch. You can spend the evening in rest or have a boat ride or a Nature walk or any activity of your choice. This is an optional activity therefore not covered for Stay at Lodge (Full Board)

Day 13: Lake Bunyonyi Uganda Safari

Morning: Today, you will do leisurely activities among which shall include: Bird Watching, a village walk to the Itiacwa and Bakiga communities. All cost part of the safari cost.

Day 14: Uganda Wildlife Tour to Lake Mburo National Park

Morning: After breakfast we drive to Lake Mburo National Park with a lunch stop in Mbarara town. Overnight at Rwakoho Rock or Eagle Nest Camp (Full Board).

Price: \$250 per person (including accommodation, meals, and farewell dinner).

Day 15: Transfer to Entebbe via the Uganda Equator

Total Package Price: \$3,699 per person (excluding international flights).
